Tribal Council Approves a Shelter In-Place Order

The Nooksack Tribal Council approved a Shelter In-Place Order effective from Noon March 24, 2020 until Noon April 7, 2020. This resolution is in response to mitigating the COVID-19 pandemic by providing a mandate for all individuals residing on Tribal trust land to shelter inplace.

Please do not panic. We are working tirelessly to stay ahead of this as much as possible. Be assured that certain essential activities will be allowed. Individuals may travel from their homes to:

- Provide or receive essential services such as taking care of family members or to obtain medical services;
- Engage in certain essential activities such as going to get groceries, medications, fishing, hunting and gathering; and,
- Work for essential businesses, essential infrastructure, and vital Nooksack governmental functions.

Nooksack Indian Tribe will continue to provide for the health, safety and welfare of the members during this shelter in-place time period.

When it is necessary for you to leave your home, please practice good social distancing, take great care to protect our elders, and wash your hands frequently. We cannot stress enough the value of each and every one of our members. Please join us in taking every precaution to mitigate the impacts of this virus. Please stay home.
